

Mappings in OneLogin enable you to automate changes to user attributes, roles, and groups, based on conditions that you define. Typically, you use mappings to grant application access based on user attributes stored in third-party directories. Roles and groups must be defined before creating a mapping

Important! Mappings always override attribute values that are set manually.

Creating a Mapping

To configure a mapping:

 Navigate to Users > Mappings and click New Mapping to open the Mappings page.

3. Set the **Conditions** that determine what gets mapped.

4. Set the **Actions** that you want to apply to the objects that meet the conditions.

Actions are selectable from the drop-down list. Some actions take predefined values, which are available by drop-down to the right of the Action field. Other actions take editable values, which you can enter in an edit box to the right of the Action field.

You can set multiple actions.

Take care not to set conflicting actions.

5. Click Save.
